The Catcher in the Rye SOUNTRACK ASSIGNMENT

POINTS: Soundtrack - 100

Catcher in the Rye Soundtrack

- No song will fit 100%. Your goal is to get most of the song and the mood of the song to fit your envisioned soundtrack.
- The song can't be totally off base. Knowing what doesn't work is as important as knowing what does. For example, songs with lots of "love" lyrics will just not fit for *Brave New World*
- You are to hand in your soundtrack on a CD.
- All songs on the soundtrack must be "radio friendly." The studio is insisting on a PG-13 rating.
- I will not grade incomplete soundtracks. All parts of the assignment must be done for it to get graded.
- You can only have one song per artist. The movie company you work for does not want to pay royalties to an artist twice.
- Your director has asked that you use a variety of music styles on your soundtrack. The director and the production company feel that the audience for the movie will be larger if different styles of music are used.
- Quote as much of the song as possible to show that the lyrics fit the novel/movie. You should at least have 4-5 lines (stanza) per song. The more the better. Short choices will make the director skeptical.

For example, a soundtrack of all pop songs or songs that are all available on the radio right now would not be as thought out as a soundtrack that uses a mix of oldies, obscure songs and songs from original bands/sources.
